The role of the SENCO is to identify children with special educational needs.

Liaising with the parents, other providers, outside agencies and educational psychologists.

Working with families having a strong partnership with parents putting in place SEND Support Plans with goals that the child will work towards at home and in the nursery setting.

Supporting their transition into school.
